BOURBON

The flagship spirit of the United States, regulated by the U.S. Government since May 4, 1964. The legislation strictly defined the production of Bourbon as well as making it specific to the United States. Its base of corn produces a soft, sweeter-style distillate, making it highly versatile in cocktails as well as enjoying by itself.

RYE

American Rye Whiskey follows the same regulated guidelines and criteria as bourbon, with the mash bill of its base being predominantly Rye. The rye grain produces a bigger, spicier, more austere distillate that holds up very well in cocktails and enjoying on the rocks or with a little water.

Spirits

TENNESSEE

These whiskies follow the same regulated guidelines from the U.S. Government as bourbon, however they go through what's called the Lincoln Country Process where the distillate is filtered through sugar maple charcoal before being placed in oak. This process produces a mellower, sweeter distillate than its bourbon counterparts.

IRISH WHISKEY

Due to its triple distillation technique and its grain bills, Irish whiskey tends to be a softer, light style of whiskey. While all Irish whiskey must contain malted barley – grain used in Scotch production – it is not the exclusive grain. Introducing unmalted cereal grains directly add to its lighter bodied whiskey.

JAPANESE WHISKY

Shinjiro Torii and Masataka Taketsuru are the reason this category exists. After studying the techniques used to make Scotland's finest Scotch, the pair brought them back to Japan in the 1920's to make whisky. Some of the most sought after whiskies in the world embody the true spirit and meticulous attention to detail of Japanese culture.

SCOTCH WHISKY

Scotch whisky's signature style and flavor profile comes from the use of malted barley to produce its distillates. While all single malts use the same grain, the nuances of each are defined by the region in which it is produced. Scotch whisky production is defined by six regions: Speyside, Highland, Lowlands, Campbeltown, Islay, and the Islands.

SPEYSIDE

Speyside – being the undisputed center of Scotch production – is a region of its own because of its unique characteristics that set it apart from the Highland style. Most producers use water from the river Spey – hence Speyside – in their production. These malts tend to be considered some of the most complex due to the wide range in cask finishes and elegant sweetness.

ISLANDS

While not unanimously accepted as a region of its own, these single malts tend to be lighter in style than their sister single malts. Slight smoke characteristics and full-bodied mouthfeel make these whiskies a hybrid of Islay and Highland.

HIGHLANDS

The largest producing region in Scotland, Highland malts tend to have a full-bodied, slightly oily characteristic with the subtle notes of peat and smoke. Due to its vastness in size and products, there is a wide range of flavor profiles produced in the region – from the spicy and heather-filled Northern malts to the sweeter and fruitier Southern malts.
